LOCALS EMBRACE NEW ITALIAN NEIGHBOUR BIANCA

HAYDEN PHISKIE, THE TALENTED CHEF BEHIND ELLERSLIE'S NEWEST ITALIAN HOT-SPOT BIANCA SAYS HE FEELS RIGHT AT HOME IN ELLERSLIE THANKS TO THE FRIENDLY WELCOME HE AND HIS TEAM HAVE RECEIVED FROM THE COMMUNITY SINCE OPENING IN DECEMBER.

"There's a really nice community feel here, it reminds me a bit of what it was like at The Refreshment Room in Titirangi – there's that same warm, friendly vibe from the locals," he says.

It's not just Ellerslie locals who are embracing Bianca. Foodies from all over Auckland are flocking to the deli for their fresh house-made pasta and ragu packs to takeaway and cook at home and their sumptuous dine in and take away menu.

Lunch from the cabinet includes a simple but on-point menu of fresh focaccias (gorgonzola, pistachio and honey is the hot favourite), ricotta-filled cannoli, a tart and cookie. Lunch time diners can also enjoy the full dinner menu complete with a glass of wine.

Dinner favourites comprise of ravioli with broad bean, lemon with sourdough crumbs and rotolo with ricotta and beef cheek ragu.

Hayden says the tight-knit Bianca team have

been working together for the past three years, most recently at Ada in Grey Lynn.

"You're only as good as your team. We all share the load, and we just really enjoy working together. Everyone does everything – our kitchen crew will be out serving food, and likewise our front of house guys are helping out the back when needed. Our opening night here was the smoothest I've ever experienced thanks to the team," he says.

With a humming commercial kitchen, 26-seat restaurant and deli, there is still plenty more in the pipeline for Hayden and Bianca.



THE ELLERSLIE RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION (ERA) IS A SMALL **VOLUNTARY GROUP WITH A GOAL TO MAKE ELLERSLIE AUCKLAND'S** MOST LIVEABLE SUBURB.

Glen McCabe, Chair, has been an Ellerslie local since 2012 and says our suburb has the bones of everything you could wish for... but there is always more you can do to make things that little bit better for everyone.

"We bring people together, generate ideas and then get those ideas in front of decision makers. We are fortunate that the Ōrakei Local Board are very supportive of us and a member will often attend our meetings," he says.

Recent ERA projects include pathway lighting at Michael's Ave Reserve and free community e-waste collections. They are engaged with Fletcher Living regarding The Hill development and are involved in discussions around transport, stormwater, parks and green spaces including the future of Liston Park. They also host community meetings during Council, mayoral and general elections to connect candidates with residents.

"We always welcome new members - maybe you've got ideas or a passion project but aren't sure how to approach it yourself, just come along. In particular, we're looking for a new Treasurer, so if you're good with numbers, we'd love to hear from you. We don't have massive resources, our resources are our ideas and being able to connect to the right people. It isn't a massive commitment, but it is very rewarding." he says.
