CIRCUS COMPANY DUST PALACE HAS TRANSFORMED THE ELLERSLIE WAR MEMORIAL INTO ELLERSLIE ARTS, A VIBRANT NEW CREATIVE HUB WITH ARTIST STUDIOS, A CIRCUS SCHOOL, LIVE PERFORMANCES AND SPACES TO HIRE.

Since 2009, the Dust Palace Charitable Trust has championed circus as an art form in Aotearoa, making it more accessible and inclusive. Rachael Dubois, Producer says their circus school welcomes a diverse community, including lots of female, rainbow, and neurodiverse students.

"Circus builds strength, flexibility, and teamwork. It's physically demanding but non-competitive and highly social. It is great for those seeking an alternative to traditional team sports, and unlike dance or gymnastics, circus focuses on technique without rigidity," she says.

FROM HER FLOWER SHOP IN THE HEART OF THE VILLAGE, KERRY MCCULLOUGH BRINGS COLOUR, JOY AND A FRIENDLY SMILE TO ALL WHO COME IN CONTACT WITH THIS ELLERSLIE ICON.

At age sixteen, Kerry left sleepy Gisborne for her big OE and after a short stint in the UK working in hospitality she settled in America where she stayed for thirty years. "I did a flower course and then opened a business in Vail, Colorado which was a popular wedding destination," she explains. "We did a lot of big events and I travelled all over America, spending time doing jobs in New York and even did a week-long event at the MET which was amazing."

Sixteen years ago, Kerry returned to New Zealand after buying the flower shop in Remuera online while still overseas. Several

years ago, she relocated to Ellerslie and has been a staple in the Village ever since.

Kerry says everyone stops to pat Daphne, her fifteen-year-old Westie who spends a lot of the day sleeping. "It's been nice watching the local kids grow up – it's a great community here in Ellerslie – I encourage everyone to keep our village vibrant and busy by visiting often and doing your errands here," she says.

Kerry is at the flower auctions three times a week and despite the small shop front, she designs floral arrangements for everything from weddings to funerals, special occasions and events of all sizes, right down to corsages for school balls and custom bouquets.

In the mornings you'll often find her sitting outside Richoux's drinking a long-black and keeping an eye on the shop, and once she's knocked off for the day, you might find her catching up with friends at Charlie Baxters.

Goneburger's Belly of the Beast



Josh's Slow Cooked Honey Soy Chicken -

The team at Ellerslie Meats know a thing or two about meat and preparing hearty dinners for busy people. Here's Josh's super simple slow cooker chicken recipe.

In a bowl mix:

- 1 cup of honey
- 1 cup of soy sauce
- 1 cup of sweet chilli sauce
- 1 tablespoon of crushed garlic 1 tablespoon of chilli powder (optional)

Add 1 kg of boneless chicken thighs and cook on low in the slow cooker for five hours Pull the chicken out and shred add a cornflour slurry to thicken the sauce. add the chicken back into the sauce and serve on rice.
